FACILITY GUIDELINES

These fields are available for walk-on use, unless closed due to maintenance, marked for a game or too wet for play. Reservations take precedence over walk-ons. Youth teams may reserve two hours per week and adult teams may reserve one hour per week. The week runs Sunday - Saturday. Call 241-0363 or stop by 220 N Walnut to make a reservation. Light usage is \$7.50 per hour, which you make arrangements and pay for at the MRC Office.

These fields are designated as Limited Access Facilities, which means access is strictly controlled by MRC. You must have MRC's approval to use these facilities. These facilities are marked "No unauthorized practices allowed."

MRC FINANCIAL AID POLICY: It is the policy of the McPherson Recreation Commission that no one be denied access to programs because of their inability to pay. **FREE** sports programs are offered to all that qualify for free or reduced lunches. Check at your child's school office for a coupon. Coupons must be turned in prior to registration deadline. Coupons turned in after deadline must pay late fee. MRC REFUND POLICY: It is the policy of the McPherson Recreation Commission to refund 80% of the unused portion of the program fee due to medical reasons or moving from McPherson County.
