# Adult COED Softball League Rules



USSSA Coed rules will be followed with the following exceptions.

1. Players may play any position in any order, but must alternate male / female in batting order. Must be 15 years old.
2. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on city property. No smoking on the field, no profanity. Profane language will be strictly enforced.
3. Game time is forfeit time. **No steel cleats**. All spikes must be plastic.
4. Protests are allowed for ineligible players only and must be submitted in writing to the MRC Sports Director, accompanied by \$25, within 24 hours of the game. The fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
5. Teams may add to their rosters through the deadline of 8:00 p.m. Tuesday September 21nd by 10pm. The rosters are final after the date. Only the names on the rosters are eligible to play.
6. Teams must have eight players to start or continue a game. (4 women to start or continue) The 9<sup>th</sup> batter (space) **WILL NOT BE** an automatic out. If a team goes to 7 players, the game is over.
7. If a team has more men than women, the fifth woman player **is counted as an out**. (example: 5 men, 4 women. An out occurs where the 5<sup>th</sup> woman should bat) Teams may play with more women than men without penalty.
8. If a man is used as an DH, then woman must be used as well. This means that 12 players bat, and 10 play in the field. (the 2 DH's may switch onto the field at any time keeping the same batting order) Teams may use 1 woman AH, and no man, or 2 women and no men.
9. A player arriving late may enter the game during a dead ball, but must be acknowledged by the umpire.
10. Score books will be provided and should be returned to the official after each game. Make sure all players are down in the book, even if they show up late.
11. Games are 55 minutes in length. No new inning will begin after the 55th min. The following run rules apply: 15 after 3 & 4 and 10 after 5 or later.
12. Teams will provide and hit their own game balls: Men=12" Women=11" Balls must be **USSSA Classic M or Classic + for the men and any 11" ball for the women**. Balls must have blue stitches . Balls may be white or yellow.
13. The umpires will hold the game balls and switch them out during the game.
14. All league teams may hit **one home run per game**. (an out will be counted after limit is reached)
15. When a male batter receives a base on balls or intentional walk, he will be awarded first and second base with the next female batter having the option to walk or bat.
