COED T-BALL RULES



1. The game will be three innings, or one hour long, whichever occurs first. No standings or scores will be kept.
2. The home team is listed 2nd on the schedule and will occupy the 1st base dugout. They are responsible for bringing the T.
3. Base length- 45 feet Pitcher distance- 25 feet Official ball- RIF 1
4. Batters and base runners must wear helmets at all times.
5. Catchers will be 15 feet behind batters box. No batter is allowed to approach the T until the catcher is in position. Catcher will wear helmet
6. The pitcher must remain on the rubber (circle) until the ball has been struck.
7. Any player throwing his/her bat or helmet may be called out by the umpire.
8. All players must sit on the bench when not actively involved in the game. Coaches are to be in control of their teams. Only players and coaches are allowed to sit on the bench.
9. Each team will field all players on defense: 6 infielders, the rest in the outfield (short fielders and out fielders). Two defensive coaches are allowed in the outfield to assist players; however, they must not interfere with play.
10. Sides will change when every batter has had a turn at bat. Teams will bat full roster.
11. The batter is out if they do not hit a fair ball within three swings. If the ball and T are hit simultaneously, it is playable as long as it is not foul, and goes beyond the 8 foot arc.
12. When the defense gets three outs, the bases are cleared and the batting order continues until the last batter bats.
13. The last batter must score to be safe.
14. Play can be stopped during the last batter by the defensive team stepping on any base in front of any runner, or tagging them out. Defenders can throw the ball to home plate.
15. The defensive team must throw the ball to the catcher to stop play. The catcher must have control of the ball. Time is called when, in the umpire's opinion, all play is complete. Runners will be advanced or sent back at the decision of the umpire.
16. Base runners may not lead off or leave the base until the ball has been hit.
17. The umpire is in charge of the game. His/her decision on all plays is final. Protests are not allowed. If a conflict should arise, please keep in mind sportsmanship and professional conduct. Contact the MRC Sports Director the next business day if the conflict is not resolved.
18. The MRC shall place all players on teams. There will not be any switching teams or adding players to rosters unless authorized by the MRC Program Director. Participants have paid correct fees, signed the waiver, and met age requirements consistent with the league.
19. Smoking, tobacco, alcoholic beverages, or foul language are not permitted in the complex by anyone.
20. Accident insurance is not provided for the league. Parents are urged to have their children covered by health insurance.
21. Notification Policy Due to Weather / Wet Fields:
 - 1st choice: LISTEN to KNGL 1540 / KBBE 96.7 FM after 4:30pm.
 - 2nd choice: Call the MRC HOTLINE line @ 241-1331 for a recorded message after 4:30pm.
 - 3rd choice: Check the website; www.mcphersonrecreationcommission.com
 - 4th choice- Plan implemented by your coach.
22. Sportsmanship Rule: Unsportsmanlike conduct, i.e. name-calling, swearing, etc., will not be tolerated. Site supervisors and/or umpires are required to take the following immediate actions should it occur by any MRC participant:
 - a. 1st Offense (Warning): Participant will sit the remainder of the game; if action occurs within the last 15 minutes of or following the game, the participant will not be allowed to play the next game.
 - b. 2nd Offense: Participant will be eliminated from season play. Registration fees will not be refunded.
