## Machine Pitch League– 2nd / 3rd Grade Boys

- The game will be three innings, or one hour long,-whichever occurs first. No standings or scores will be kept.
  - The home team will occupy the 1st base dugout.
  - Base length- 60 feet Pitcher distance- 35 feet Official ball- RIF 5 or 10
  - Batters and base runners must wear helmets at all times. No steel cleats allowed.
  - Catchers must wear shin guards, chest protector, face mask with throat guard/helmet, and a cup.
  - Pitching machine will be used all season. Runners may not lead-off or steal, but may leave the base when the ball is released by the machine. Any batted ball hitting the machine will be called foul. Pitching machine must be set at the slowest speed that gets the ball across the plate. Set-up is done by official and/ or supervisor.
- \*\*\* Runners on third base may not go home on a passed ball or wild pitch.
- \*\*\* Base runners are allowed only one base per overthrow at his own risk. If the defending team makes a play on the base that the runner is advancing to, and that base is overthrown, the runner may go to the next base at his own risk. The overthrown ball should /could be fielded and given to the pitcher to avoid consecutive overthrows, as the ball is dead when given back to the pitcher. Base coaches should keep fair play and sportsmanship in mind when sending kids on to the next base on an overthrow. Please use your best judgment and fairness as we teach this game to the kids.
- All players must sit on the bench when not actively involved in the game. Coaches are to be in control of their teams. Only players and coaches are allowed to sit on the bench.
  - Each team may field a maximum of 11 players on defense. 6 infielders, by position, and 5 in the outfield. A maximum of two defensive coaches are allowed on the field with their team.
  - Sides will change when 3 outs or 7 runs have occurred, which ever comes first.
  - Batters are limited to 5 pitches: after that, the batter is out. (may go to 3 pitches in last inning to get through all batters)
  - The last batter must score to be safe.
  - The defensive team can get the last batter out by stepping on any base in front of any runner, or home plate. Any runner may be tagged out at any time.
  - The defensive team must throw the ball to the pitcher to stop play.- Umpire will call time to stop play.
  - The umpire is in charge of the game. His/her decision on all plays is final.** No protests allowed. **Please remember sportsmanship and professional conduct if a conflict should arise.** Contact the MRC Sports Director the next business day if the conflict is not resolved.
  - The MRC shall place all players on teams, no switching teams or adding players to rosters unless authorized by the MRC Program Director. Participants have paid correct fees, signed the waiver, and met age requirements consistent with the league.
  - Smoking, tobacco, alcoholic beverages or foul language are not permitted in the complex by anyone.
  - Accident insurance is not provided for the league. Parents are urged to have their children covered by health insurance.
  - Notification Policy Due to Weather / Wet Fields-
    - 1st choice- KNGL 1540 / KBBE 96.7 FM after 4:30pm.
    - 2nd choice- Call the MRC INFO line @ 241-1331 for a recorded message after 4:30pm.
    - 3rd choice- Plan implemented by your coach.

  - Sportsmanship Rule: Unsportsmanlike conduct, i.e. name-calling, swearing, etc., will not be tolerated. Site supervisors and/or umpires are required to take the following immediate actions should it occur by any MRC participant:
    - 1st Offense (Warning): Participant will sit the remainder of the game; if action occurs within the last 15 minutes of or following the game, the participant will not be allowed to play the next game.
    - 2nd Offense: Participant will be eliminated from season play. Registration fees will not be refunded.
