2009 Slow Pitch Rules

Applies to Open, Industrial, Church and Women's Leagues.
 Co-ed has its own rules.

All U.S.S.A. rules will be followed except where stated differently in this rules handout.

1. Home team is listed second on the schedule and will keep the official book, provided by the MRC.
2. Each team will hit their own balls (you provide). All balls must have or fall with-in the following criteria.
Men: Ball must be 12" in diameter with blue stitches. **Only balls marked as USSSA; Elite, or Majors are allowed**
Elite Ball: Cor = 43.25 +/- .75 & Comp = 355 lbs. +/- 45 lbs
Majors: Cor = 39.25 +/- .75 & Comp = 260 lbs. +/- 45 lbs
Women: Ball must be 11" in diameter with blue stitches and marked as USSSA; Distance, Elite, or Majors.
3. **Game Time is Forfeit time.**
4. **Industrial and open teams must have 9 players to start a game. The 10th batter will be an automatic out.** If a team goes to 8 players the game is over.
Church and Women's teams must have 8 to start a game. The 9th batter will be an automatic out.
 If a team goes to 7 players the game is over.
5. **No Steal Cleats are allowed.** If caught you are not allowed to finish the game!
6. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED ON THE CITY PROPERTY!** No smoking on the diamonds. Profane language will not be tolerated.
7. **Officials are in charge of the game** and are to be treated with respect. All players and spectators need to demonstrate **good sportsmanship**. Each team is responsible for their own players and spectators. Any player / spectator ejected from the game / facility must leave immediately or the proper authorities will be called to escort them out. **Any player ejected from a game will be automatically suspended from the game and for at least 14 days, possibly more.** All players or teams will be suspended for one year, for laying a hand on an official. Any players that pursues a fight will be suspended from league for at least one year. If someone commits an act in which the league feels further punishment is needed, the league committee will vote and determine the punishment, up to permanent suspension. League committee is made up of team captains.
8. All games will have a **one hour time limit** with no new innings being started after 55 minutes of play.
9. Any **Roster additions** must be made by **4 pm on game day**. All players must be at least 16 years old to play. If your team is adding someone from outside USD 418 school district they must pay their \$8 fee before they are allowed to play. **You will not be able to add players to your roster after will be Friday, June 19th 2009.**
10. All **men's leagues** will have a **3 home run limit** (USSSA rules: Corporate men's class B and church men's class B).
Women's league will not have a home run limit (USSSA rule: Women's class B).
11. **Run Rule** will be **15 after 3 innings** and **10 after 5 innings** for all leagues.
12. **League descriptions:**
Church - All players must play for the church they attend. A player may not play for another church team if their church has a team in the league.
Industrial - Player's or player's spouse must be employed by the business(es) sponsoring the team.
Open - Anyone is eligible to play in this league.
Women - Any female that wishes to play.

Bats approved for USSSA play will be allowed. A bats list is available on ussa.com.
