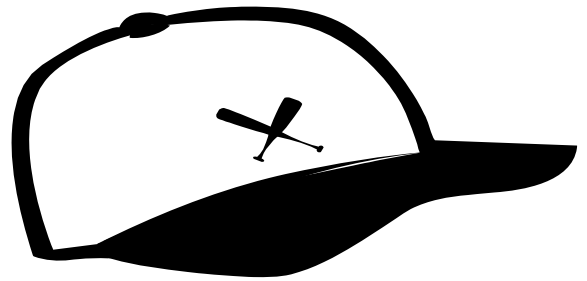

Rules for 6th—8th Grade Boys Pitch- Baseball

All rules established by the U.S.S.S.A will be followed except where listed.

1. The game will be six innings, or one and a half hours long,-whichever occurs first. If a team is ahead by 10 runs after 4 innings, (3 1/2 innings if the home team is ahead) the game will be called. No new inning will start after one hour and 15 minutes of play. Once an inning is started, it will be finished. In case of rain, the score will revert back to the last complete inning played and will be official if three innings have been completed. If three innings have not been completed, the game will be re-played from the beginning as the season allows. Games may end in a tie.
2. The home team is listed 1st on the schedule, and will occupy the 1st base dugout. The home team will also keep the official book. You will be provide with a score book.
3. Base length - 70 feet Pitcher distance - 50 feet Official ball - regular little league baseballs.
4. Batters and base runners must wear helmets at all times. No steel cleats allowed.
5. Catchers must wear shin guards, chest protector, helmet/ face mask with throat guard and a cup.
6. Eight players must be present to start and finish a game. (no out in 9th spot) Game time is forfeit time. Players may be loaned from the opposing team (if needed) to play the game, but will be recorded as a forfeit.
7. Any player throwing his/her bat or helmet may be called out or ejected by the umpire. Any player intentionally taking his helmet off during play will be automatically out.
8. All players must sit on the bench when not actively involved in the game. Coaches are to be in control of their teams. Only players and coaches are allowed to sit on the bench.
9. Each team will field 9 players on defense.
10. Every player must play an equal amount of time and start the same number of games. Players may not be benched for missing practices or for discipline problems without notifying the parents and MRC Sports Director.
11. Teams may bat entire roster. Free substitution permitted during the game. Batting order does not change.
12. **Pitchers may not pitch more than five innings per calendar week- Sun. - Sat.**
13. Bunting, lead offs (2 slide steps from side of base), and base stealing is allowed. Runners may steal any base but home, but may go home on a wild pitch, passed ball, or if the defense trys to make a play on any runner. Any player going home must slide or attempt to slide when there is a play at the plate. The crash rule is in effect. Batters may advance to first on a dropped third strike if no one is on 1st base, and there are less than two outs. (meaning, if the dropped 3rd strike is the 3rd out, the batter is out- may not try for first.)
14. A limit of 9 runs can be scored in an inning. Teams trade sides after the 9th run, as if there were three outs.
15. The umpire is in charge of the game. His/her decision on all plays is final. No protests allowed. Please remember sportsmanship and professional conduct if a conflict should arise. Contact the Recreation Director the next business day if the conflict is not resolved.
16. Program Directors shall place all players on teams, no switching teams or adding players to rosters unless authorized by the Program Director. Participants have paid correct fees, signed the waiver, and met age requirements consistent with the league.
17. Smoking, tobacco, alcoholic beverages or foul language are not permitted in the complex by anyone.
18. Accident insurance is not provided for the league. Parents are urged to have children covered by a health insurance plan.
